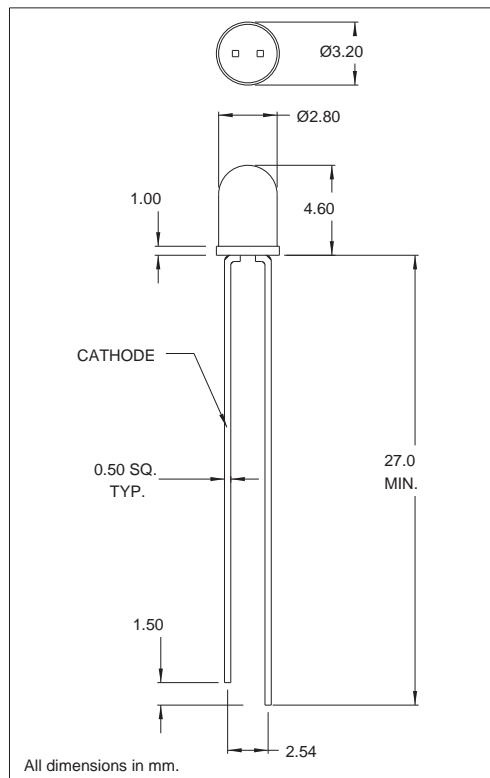




T-1 Super Brite LED Lamps
